Preventing Forgotten Cooking

Medication burden, memory changes, and fatigue can turn a simple cooking task into a serious risk.

Forgotten or unattended cooking is one of the leading causes of home fires and injuries among older adults. It's rarely about carelessness. It's often about real, manageable risk factors.

How a small distraction can lead to a major incident



Why does taking prescription medication matter to stove fires?

Many medications can affect alertness, attention, balance, or memory. Taking multiple medications increases the chance of side effects, interactions, and confusion. These effects can make it easier to forget about cooking or respond more slowly when something goes wrong.



May cause drowsiness, brain fog, or slowed reaction time



Interactions can increase confusion or disorientation



Complex regimens are harder to manage consistently

From Stove Shutoff To Managed Response

Automatic shutoff matters, Context, escalation, and follow-through make it operational.

Stove protection is most valuable when it does more than interrupt heat. Care Daily adds context, escalation, documentation, and follow-up so a shutoff event becomes part of a managed response workflow.

One Safety Layer. Many Risk Areas.

The same response layer that protects the kitchen can also help reduce property and environmental risk across the community.

Property owners need earlier visibility into the small incidents that create repair costs, downtime, and resident disruption.



Water Leaks

3,000+ Water Leaks Detected

Average claim: \$15,400 | Severe losses: \$1M+

Care Daily has detected over 3,000 water leaks across bathrooms, toilets, water heaters, washing machines, under-the-sink areas, and other places where a small leak can become expensive if no one sees it early.



Mold And Mildew Predictions

Average remediation: \$2,368 |
Hidden or whole-home: \$10,000–\$30,000

Care Daily predicts mold and mildew growth risk by sensing temperature and humidity conditions associated with moisture buildup.



Smoke And Fire

Average claim: \$88,170 |
Reported apartment fires: \$10M–\$12M+

Smoke alerts can route through Care Daily so the event is not just heard locally, but acted on quickly.



Carbon Monoxide

Carbon monoxide is a life-safety and liability risk. Severe or fatal events can exceed \$1.06M in societal cost per death before litigation or reputational harm.



Refrigerators & Freezers

Food spoilage: \$500–\$1,000 |
Cold-chain losses: \$22,000–\$40,000

Temperature monitoring can help surface refrigerator and freezer failures before spoilage, medication loss, or cleanup becomes a larger problem.



Power Outages

Average outage: \$6,031 |
High-risk outages: \$140,000

Power-outage awareness can help communities respond faster when outages disrupt appliances, environmental conditions, or resident safety.
